WHY IS A REFERENDUM NEEDED?

MIDDLE SCHOOL (built in 1922)

- Major building systems (plumbing, heating/ ventilation, and electrical) have exceeded their service life and need to be replaced.
- Site Safety (the site is too small, has limited green space, congested traffic, and insufficient parking).
- Inadequate classrooms and support areas.

WASHINGTON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL (built in 1949)

- Update major building systems (fire alarms/ sprinklers. heating, plumbing, electrical, etc.).
- Additional classroom space is needed to accommodate Wilson Elementary School students.
- Provide a better instructional environment for students.

- Playground Improvements
