Reader's Workshop

We continued to read about gardening this week with It's Our Garden! Students have been practicing the skills of using text and graphic features (illustrations, headings, captions) and structure of a text to gain a deeper understanding of a text. We have also begun some chapter books this week in our small reading groups!

Math

Students have continued studying scaled and picture graphs this week and using their knowledge of the four operations to answer questions. We are also working hard to practice those multiplication facts to be fluent by the end of third grade.

Writing/ Grammar

The students have been using their knowledge of poetry to work on a special writing piece this week. Later on, they will learn more about their country research reports!

In grammar this week, students are reviewing how to write a series of nouns or verbs in a sentence using commas: The girls read, played, and ran during their recess.

Social Studies

Students are wrapping up their unit on celebrating communities this week, as they learn more about ways people may celebrate and share their cultures with others! This lends itself perfectly to our big writing project!
